- 31.7.1556 † **St Ignatius of Loyola**, founder of the Jesuit Order

- 21.12.1781 Jan Hrdlička, first Protestant pastor A.C. came after the Patent of Toleration into Moravia, in order to make a worship at Vsetín
- 22.12.1421 the victory of the Hussites upon crusaders near Kutná Hora
- 24.12.1616 † György **Thurzó**, Protestant belief defender in Slovakia, Orava Governor and the Palatine of Hungary
- 25.12.1856 \* Dr Juraj **Janoška**, first general bishop Evangelical Church of the Augsburg Confession in Slovakia, Parliament deputy and politic
